All horse and rider combinations may enter Jumper classes at and up to two levels above the height they are jumping for combined training. Any horse and rider combination not competing in a combined test may enter up to three consecutive levels of jumper classes. Fences in Gambler's Choice will range from 2'-3" to 3'-7" and may be jumped or skipped at the discretion of the rider.

Directions: From Atlanta take I-75 North to exit #278 Glade Road. Turn LEFT at bottom of ramp. At top of hill turn RIGHT onto Hwy 92/Lake Acworth Drive. Follow to dead end and turn RIGHT onto Hwy 41/Cobb Pkwy. Cross over lake and turn LEFT at a stoplight onto Black Acre Trail (it's called Third Army on the right). Go approximately 7 miles until dead end and turn LEFT onto Hwy 61/Cartersville Hwy. Take your first LEFT onto Williams Road (into Burnt Hickory Subdivision). Follow Williams thru subdivision until it becomes a gravel road; fork RIGHT to stay on Williams. Follow gravel road straight ahead thru front gates at Foxberry Farm.

All CT and Intro Level Tests will be ridden in a small arena. All Training Level and above Tests will be ridden in a large arena. Cross-country will be held in a mostly enclosed, gently rolling grass field. Stadium will be held in a fully enclosed sand arena. Longing will be permitted in pasture/parking areas only, not in warm-up arena.

All competitors may carry a whip. Pre-Amoeba, Amoeba and dressage only competitors may use a caller for dressage.

Awards will be given to 6th place in each Horse Trials Division and to 6th place for each dressage class. End of Year Championships will be given for each Horse Trials level and each Dressage level. Points will accumulate during the show series. You must compete in at least two shows at the same level to qualify.

Novice Level cross country course will consist of mainly Beginner Novice Level fences at Novice time. Novice Level stadium jumps will be Novice height.

To prevent elimination at Pre-Amoeba and Amoeba Levels a ghost score will be given for any fault warranting elimination and ribbons will be given through 6th place to competitors that complete both phases.

Show management may divide classes if entries warrant. Show management may ask any competitor or spectator exhibiting unsafe or disrespectful behavior to leave the show grounds immediately. Show management will refer to the 2010 USEF Rules for Dressage and Eventing. All decisions made by the show management are final.

All riders are required to wear a helmet that meets ASTM/SEI requirements at all times while mounted. Riders must wear a protective vest during the cross-country phase. Proper show attire is preferred. Show coats will be excused weather permitting. Braiding is optional.

Stadium schooling rounds will be held immediately following each level. Riders may only school courses held after their level of competition. The cross-country course will be open for schooling immediately following the show.

Concession stand and restrooms will be available on grounds. All dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

RIDER RELEASE AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into by and between _____ (hereinafter referred to as "Rider") and FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, LLC at FOXBERRY FARM, LLC (herein after referred to as "Foxberry Riding Academy").

1. The undersigned acknowledges and fully understands that all RIDER'S use the property, equipment and facilities of FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY and FOXBERRY FARM, LLC at his or her own risk. Furthermore, the RIDER hereby releases DEBORAH G. VAN SANT, THOMAS J. VAN SANT, FOXBERRY FARM LLC, KIMOTHY ABERNATHY, JOY L. BUCHANAN, LAUREL MARSH, FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, any landowner, their agents, officers, directors, employees, trainers, successors, assigns, executors, heirs, and administrators from any and all claims, causes of action, obligations, responsibilities, demands, liabilities and damages – whether now existing, accruing or maturing at any time – in any way related to or arising out of RIDER'S use of FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, FOXBERRY FARM or such landowner's property, horses, equipment or facilities except for FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY or FOXBERRY FARM, LLC's gross negligence.

The RIDER agrees to hold and save DEBORAH G. VAN SANT, THOMAS J. VAN SANT, FOXBERRY FARM LLC, KIMOTHY ABERNATHY, JOY L. BUCHANAN, LAUREL MARSH, FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, any landowner, their agents, officers, directors, employees, trainers, successors, assigns, executors, heirs, and administrators harmless from each and every claim, demand, liability or other obligation which may arise or be connected with loss, injury, or damage, to RIDER or his property.

2. The RIDER agrees and covenants never to bring any action at law or in equity against DEBORAH G. VAN SANT, THOMAS J. VAN SANT, FOXBERRY FARM LLC, KIMOTHY ABERNATHY, JOY L. BUCHANAN, LAUREL MARSH, FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, any landowner, their agents, officers, directors, employees, trainers, successors, assigns, executors, heirs, and administrators on behalf of Rider, whether a minor or adult, arising from, or related to any injury, damage or other loss to person or property suffered by rider, and connected with RIDER'S use of FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, FOXBERRY FARM'S property, equipment, or facilities; and the HORSE OWNER shall defend DEBORAH G. VAN SANT, THOMAS J. VAN SANT, FOXBERRY FARM LLC, KIMOTHY ABERNATHY, JOY L. BUCHANAN, LAUREL MARSH, FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, any landowner, their agents, officers, directors, employees, trainers, successors, assigns, executors, heirs, and administrators against any such actions brought by RIDER on RIDER's behalf with respect to RIDER'S use of FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, FOXBERRY FARM'S or RIDER'S property, equipment, horses, or facilities and shall indemnify DEBORAH G. VAN SANT, THOMAS J. VAN SANT, FOXBERRY FARM LLC, KIMOTHY ABERNATHY, JOY L. BUCHANAN, LAUREL MARSH, FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY, any landowner, their agents, officers, directors, employees, trainers, successors, assigns, executors, heirs, and administrators for anything for which Rider is responsible, either alone, or jointly, or severally.

3. RIDER hereby agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY and FOXBERRY FARM as amended from time to time.

4. RIDER hereby agrees to pay FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY promptly upon receipt of invoice, all costs and expenses for the repair or replacement of any property – whether owned by FOXBERRY RIDING ACADEMY or FOXBERRY FARM or not – damaged, destroyed, injured, or otherwise harmed by any action or inaction of RIDER or any of RIDER'S horses. Examples include, but are not limited to damage, destruction, or injury to jumps, fencing, stalls, gates, buckets, tack or horses.

5. This Agreement shall be governed and interpreted exclusively by and under the laws of the State of Georgia.

GDCTA Hold Harmless Clause

The undersigned competitor and all signors below hereby (1) agrees to release the management of this show, their officers, directors, employees, members, or agents, and the owners or managers of the grounds where this event is held, from any loss, damage, liability, or injury arising out of or resulting from this show or competitors participation therein; (2) agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the Georgia Dressage and Combined Training Association, Inc., the organizer, facility owner, and the management of this show from and against any and all claims for loss, damage, liability, or injury, however caused, resulting directly or indirectly from competitors entry or participation in this show or from acts or omissions of competitor or competitor's agents; and (3) acknowledges that activities with and around horses and horse shows involve inherent risks that are understood by the persons signing and are expressly assumed. In the event of injury to competitor or to competitor's animals permission is hereby granted to management for emergency medical treatment.

Every entry at a Georgia Dressage and Combined Training Association, Inc. (GDCTA) recognized competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, handler, and the horse), for themselves, their principals, representatives, employees, and agents: (1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of the GDCTA and the local rules of the competition; (2) represent that every horse, rider, driver, and handler is eligible as entered; (3) agree to be bound by the constitution and rules of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF) and of the competition, and will accept as final the decision of the hearing committee on any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the competition, the GDCTA, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken; (4) agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, they authorize the GDCTA and the competition management to market, transfer, assign, or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes, or videotapes taken of the horse(s) and participant(s) while on the grounds, incident to, or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in any way they see fit for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the event, sport, or the GDCTA, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation; and (5) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risks of injury or loss, and they agree to indemnify and hold harmless the GDCTA, the competition, and the officials, directors, employees, and agents from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the competition, whether or not such claim, injury, or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts or omissions of said officials, directors, employees, or agents of the GDCTA or competition. The construction and application of USEF Rules are governed by laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against USEF must be filed in New York State, see Article 1502.5.
